Under this agreement for 2019 Eagleby State School will receive

\$409,505*

This funding will be used to

- Increase NAPLAN Reading in Year 3 U2B from 14.3% (2013) – 30.1% (2018) to 45% by 2020 NAPLAN
- Increase NAPLAN Writing in Year 3 U2B from 13.3% (2014) – 26.1% (2018) to 30% by 2020 NAPLAN
- Increase NAPLAN Numeracy in Year 3 U2B from 10.7% (2013) – 34.3% (2018) to 45% by 2020 NAPLAN

Our initiatives include

- Advancing teacher capability means formative urgency leading to rigorous intent and focus;
- Effective Pedagogy applies Cognitive Complexity which includes Questioning, Conflict, Contradictions; Challenge, Intellectual Risk, Construction;
- Meaningful cognitively complex real life tasks are the product of innovative planning and provide engagement for teachers and students; Stage 1, 2 & 3 Planning by Design; Phase 1 & 2 in Stage 2 as Real World Topics;
- Explicit targeted differentiated instruction includes responsive questioning, feedback and feedforward; Literacy and Numeracy Blocks; Reading and Numeracy Intervention plus Oral Language intervention programs;
- Differentiate learning for teachers using Pedagogy Indicators which align to Professional Learning Plans and formal observations, feedback, feed-forward; Professional Learning Teams (PLTs) participate in weekly focus meeting to ensure on targeted student learning against learning indicators;
- Ensure Short Term Data Formative Data cycles occur every five weeks rigorously challenging the effectiveness of instruction in Literacy and Numeracy Blocks;
- Provide Co Teaching teams, who team teach in Literacy and Numeracy Blocks with a teacher for differentiated cycles; Co Teachers provide evidence of their pedagogical influence through Short Term Data cycles illustrating pedagogical movement against teacher indicators;
- Atomic Theory Science Prep to Year 6; Periodic Table = Chemistry, Photosynthesis, Human Body = Biology; Space, Gravity = Physics; Train the trainer complete; Science resources boxes;
- Advanced Computer Science – Coding Year 3 – 6; ICT resources extended: Laptops, iPads, Interactive Whiteboards
- Arts program extended: Visual Arts and Drama teacher for Prep to Year 6

* Funding amount estimated on 2018 data. Actual funding will be determined after 2019 enrolment data are finalised. Actual expenditure may be varied due to changes in finalised 2019 enrolment data and student learning needs.
